**A. 300 East Main Street** – **roof and signage.** Eric Saile was present to explain the project. The First Presbyterian Church wanted to replace a portion of the roof. The shingles are the same color and the same design as the other shingles that are currently on the church.

The church also wanted to replace the current sign with three new signs. Mr. Saile explained that currently the sign is on the North West corner of the property with one side facing East Main Street and the other facing Liberty Street. He explained since it is on the corner no-one can see the sign until they have passed the church. The church decided that they would like one sign at each entrance to the parking lot and one in the parking lot next to the sidewalk that goes into the church itself. All the signs have been reviewed by the City of Batavia Zoning Officer per the new sign code. Signs have to be of a monument style versus a pole style.
