




# Socio-Economic Review

1960 to 2014	GAINED 2,490 residents (57.6%)	LOST 3,133 residents (-17.2%)
2000 to 2014	GAINED 900 residents (15.2%)	LOST 1,179 residents (-7.3%)



Between 1960 to 2014, Genesee County has experienced a net increase of 5,160 residents (9.6%).

More recent trends, 2000 to 2014, indicate a slight change in the trend with a loss of 1,208 (2%).


## Age Composition



## Commuting Patterns



Batavia is an employment center for the county and the surrounding region:

- 9,269 jobs in City
- 7,004 come **into** City:
  - Genesee County: 58.7%
  - Erie County: 8.8%
  - Wyoming County: 7.9%
  - Monroe County: 7.1%
- 4,514 **leave** City:
  - Genesee County: 49.6%
  - Erie County: 18.2%
  - Monroe County: 17.2%
