



Consultant Selection for Comprehensive Plan Update



Engineering Consultant Agreement

Date: August 10, 2015

On March 9, 2015 the City Council adopted a resolution to enter into an agreement with New York State for preliminary engineering and design for sidewalk reconstruction for the Healthy Schools Corridor. The sum of \$72,000 was authorized by the Federal Highway Administration (FHA) in May 2015 for the preliminary design which allowed the City to begin the selection process for engineering services. Additional phases for this project include detail design, and construction inspection for a total engineering services cost of \$210,000. The additional phases will not be started until FHA authorization is obtained.

This is a federally funded, locally administered project. The City invited all 15 engineering firms that have been precertified by NYSDOT Region 4 to submit a letter of interest for the Healthy Schools Corridor project. Each firm was asked to submit the following:

- Description of similar projects completed by the firm
- Technical experience
- Proposed project team and their involvement with similar projects
- Team's approach and understanding of the Healthy Schools Corridor project

A consultant selection committee was established along with criteria to be considered when scoring the nine engineering submittals. After independent review by each member of the committee, Erdman Anthony received the highest score and was then asked to submit a Scope of Services to provide preliminary design for the Healthy Schools Corridor project.

The scope of services provided by Erdman Anthony was reviewed by City staff and revised to meet project needs and budget.

The final Scope of Services for engineering services is quite lengthy and is available for your review at the Department of Public Works.

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ERDMAN ANTHONY FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CITY OF BATAVIA HEALTHY SCHOOLS CORRIDOR

Motion by Councilperson

WHEREAS, a Project for the Reconstruction of Sidewalks for Healthy Schools Corridor, P.I.N. 4755.93, is eligible for funding under Title 23 U.S. Code, as amended, that calls the apportionment of the costs of such program to be borne at the ratio of 80% Federal funds and 20% non-federal funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Batavia desires to advance the Project, and has previously entered into an Agreement with the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) for the City to administer this project, and

WHEREAS, a request for proposals were received for a consultant to perform the Engineering Services, and a committee of City and NYSDOT personnel selected Erdman Anthony to perform the work; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that City Council approves the award of a contract for Engineering Services for the Reconstruction of Sidewalks for the Healthy Schools Corridor to Erdman Anthony for \$ 210,000 or as otherwise modified by New York State Department of Transportation.

Youth Reserves - Replace Rotted Posts and Fence Gate

In the 2015/2016 budget, Council approved to use \$25,000 in facility reserves to repair the Youth Bureau's roof. The lowest quote for the repair of the roof came from R.A. Haitz Co., Inc. at \$9,113.00. This leaves \$15,887.00 in reserves that were earmarked for the Youth Bureau.

This memo is requesting that we permit the Youth Bureau to use approximately \$5,000 of the remaining budgeted facility reserve to replace rotted posts in their fencing and to replace their fence gate. Quotes for the posts have come in around \$1,200. The gate replacement has not yet been quoted.

#-2015 A RESOLUTION TO USE FACILITY RESERVES FOR YOUTH BUREAU FENCE REPAIR

WHEREAS, The City of Batavia approved in the 2015/20156 budget to use \$25,000 of facility reserve to repair the Youth Bureau roof; and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid for the Youth Bureau roof was \$9,113 therefore leaving a remainder of budgeted reserves in the amount of \$15,887; and

WHEREAS, the City of Batavia Youth Bureau's fence is in need of repair as their posts are rotting therefore not keeping the fence in an upright position and the fence's gate is in need of replacement. Such repairs are estimated to cost approximately \$5,000; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Batavia that the City Manager is authorized to use up to \$5,000 of budgeted reserves to repair the fence and fence gate at the Youth Bureau.
