

## Memorandum

To: Honorable City Council

From: Tom Phelps, Superintendent of Water & Wastewater

Date: September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023

Subject: HVAC Repair and Boiler Installation.

The Bureau of Water and Wastewater issued a Request for Bids in August, 2023 for the HVAC repair and Boiler installation. This is for the Priority Improvement Project at the Water treatment Plant.

Bids documents were opened on September 7<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and reviewed by City and GHD staff. We had 2 different bidders on the project. After opening the bids and reviewing all the bids we decided to move forward in the process with John W. Danforth Company of Tonawanda NY as the winning bidder in the amount of \$154,400 for the Project.

We recommended City Council to award the contracts at the September 11<sup>th</sup> 2023 business meeting.

Supporting Documentation: Bid Tabulation Resolution

This institution is an equal opportunity provider and employer. 
