



In follow up to our discussions concerning the bids received for the WWTP Pond A2 cleaning project, we comment as follows:

In summary, the bid received from GFL Environmental (copy attached) contained extraneous information that in our opinion renders the bid non-responsive.

Specifically, statements made in the submission made certain assertions that, if accepted, could negatively affect the City's ability to enforce certain material terms of the contract specification regarding Means and Methods, cost(s) and protection of the facility's pond liner and air piping systems.

As such, award of the subject project to CFL Environmental is not recommended by this office.

As for the apparent second low bidders bid, Denali (copy attached), pricing is exorbitant and therefore said bid should also be rejected.
