SUBJECT: Plumbing Regulations

Below is a listing of State, Local Laws and Regulations which pertain directly to Licensed Plumbers within the City of Batavia.

- New York State General City Law, Chapter 21, Article 4 of the Executive Law, Paragraphs 40-47, Volume 15B of Consolidated Laws Service. This is the basic State Law providing for licensing of plumbers within certain cities of the State.
- City charter, Chapter 8, defines responsibilities for sewer and water lines.
- City Ordinance Plumbing Standards, Article VI of Building Code Enforcement, Chapter 26, requires licensed plumbers on private property within buildings.

The exception is for homeowners who wish to perform plumbing within their dwellings as detailed in 26.62 Paragraph F.

- City Ordinance Demolition work Chapter 26, Article VII
- City Ordinance Water Service Chapter 45 has been rewritten and currently is under review by City Council. It will include backflow prevention on certain water services.
- City Ordinance Sanitary Sewers C
- Chapter 46 includes pretreatment and regulations for storm and sanitary sewer systems.
- All plumbing work must conform to New York State Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code Requirements. This code allows some discretion to the local Plumbing Board and some interpretations for the Local Code Enforcement Officer.

Below are City of Batavia Plumbing Board Local Rules and Regulation adopted by the Board. These Rules and Regulations are not intended to conflict with any State, Federal, or Local Laws or Requirements.

The Board of Plumbing Examiners was formed for the purpose of ensuring that all persons engaging in the business of providing plumbing services for fee be competent craftsmen and that all such services be performed in accordance with accepted standards, applicable laws of the State of New York, and the Municipal Code of the City of Batavia.

All Rules and Regulation of the Board of Plumbing Examiner's hereinafter called "The Board" shall comply with the City of Batavia Municipal Code and with Article 4 of the General City Law, and all rules and Regulations applicable to plumbing contained in the City of Batavia Municipal Code or in the General City Law are hereby adopted as Rules and Regulations of the Board of Plumbing Examiners.

<u>Certificate of Registration:</u> Upon payment of a fee, the Plumbing Inspector shall issue a Certificate of Registration to any person holding a valid Certificate of Competency,

<u>Licensed Plumber Sign:</u> Upon payment of a fee, the Plumbing Inspector shall issue to any holder of a valid Certificate of Registration, a metal sign in accordance with Article 4, Section 45b of the General City Law. This sign shall be valid for so long as the plumber shall hold a valid Certificate of Registration, and shall be surrendered to the Plumbing Inspector within ten (10) days of either the expiration or the revocation of the Certificate of Registration.

<u>Suspension:</u> A licensed plumber whose license has been suspended by the Board shall, within forty-eight (48) hours of such suspension order, surrender both his/her Certificate of Registration and his/her "Licensed Plumber" sign to the Plumbing Inspector. Both the Certificate of Registration and the sign will be returned without charge when and if the suspension is lifted by the Board.

Revocation: A licensed plumber whose license has been revoked by the Board shall surrender his/her Certificate of Competency, Certificate of Registration, and "Licensed Plumber" sign to the Plumbing Inspector within twenty-four (24) hours of the time that his licensed was revoked. When and if such revocation is rescinded by the Board, a new license must be obtained in accordance with above paragraph to include a new application, qualification by examination before the Board, and payment of all applicable fees. In no case shall a license be revoked for a period of less than thirty (30) days.

APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY

- (a). Application for a Certificate of competency will be received at the office of the Plumbing Inspector during normal working hours. Such application shall be filed on the form to be provided by the Plumbing Inspector, and shall be accompanied by the fee as required by law. (Applications shall be received no later than December 1 for the February exam, and July 1 for the September exam.)
- (b). Upon approval of the Application, the applicant shall submit to a written examination which is generally given in February and September. The qualifications required for approval of an Application for a Certificate of Competency are:

- 1. Must be Master Plumber holding a Certificate of Competency which was obtained by passing a written exam given by another Plumbing Board from another City in New York State; or,
- 2. Four (4) years working for a Master Plumber holding a Certificate of Competency which was obtained by passing a written exam given by a Plumbing Board; or,
- 3. Combination of working for two (2) years for a Master Plumber holding a Certificate of Competency which was obtained by passing a written exam given by a Plumbing Board and successful completion of two (2) semesters of an approved trade school; or,
- 4. The Board shall waive the requirements prescribed in the foregoing paragraphs provided that the applicant's training and experience is substantially equivalent to such qualifications.

Substantial Equivalence shall be:

- a. A person not working for a Master Plumber but has been working in the plumbing trade with "hands on" experience for eight (8) years; or,
- b. A combination of all working experience and education, if any, shall be considered by the Board to be equal to a total of eight (8) years experience.
- c. For paragraphs 2 and 3 and subparagraphs (a) and (b) above, one (1) year's experience shall be equivalent to 1,000 hours of working.

It shall be the applicant's obligation to provide written documentation of proof of experience and education.

The Board shall refuse to approve an application from any person who at the time of the same may be unlawfully engaged in the business as a Master or Employing Plumber, or who has been convicted of such unlawful engagement within a two (2) year period prior to such application.

Applicants will be screened by City personnel to verify experience and qualifications prior to the application being presented to the Board for approval. If the applicant is qualified, s/he will be scheduled for the examination. The written examination shall be one given and corrected by a private testing agency previously approved by the Board. A score of 70% shall be deemed as passing.

When an applicant fails to qualify for a Certificate of Competency, s/he may not submit a new application for a period of one (1) month from the date of such finding. If after the second plumbing test failure in one (1) year, there will be a period of one (1) year from the date of the second test failure before another application can be submitted to the Plumbing Board.

QUORUM

No Examining Board of Plumbers shall be conducted with less than three (3) members present.

Three (3) affirmative votes shall be required to carry any motion before the Board.

AGENDA

A written agenda shall be prepared by the Secretary and distributed to the membership five (5) days before any regularly scheduled meeting. Any member may have an item placed on the agenda by submitting a written request to the Secretary within fifteen (15) days of the meeting.

Old Business shall receive first priority at any scheduled meeting. New business items on the agenda shall receive priority over discussion of any item not on the agenda.

MINUTES

Minutes of all meetings shall be prepared and distributed by the Secretary within ten (10) days of any meeting. Distribution of these minutes shall be to the membership and to any other individuals so designated by the City Administrator.

Below are specific items concerning the plumbing trade approved by the City of Batavia Examining Board of Plumbers.

- P-1 all water lines inside buildings must meet the specification of the Plumbing Code of New York State, except that no galvanized water pipe shall be allowed. Water piping 4" or larger in diameter may be copper, Class 52 Ductile or cast iron and 200 PSI poly piping, copper tube size and approved fittings up to and including 24" NPS in size with an approved tracer wire.
- P-2 All water service pipes outside building must meet the specifications of the Plumbing Code of New York State and must be at least ³/₄" in diameter. No galvanized pipes allowed.
- P-3 Sanitary Sewers and Storm Sewers Underground, Aboveground, Inside or Outside Class 52 Ductile Iron, Service Weight Cast Iron, Schedule 40 PVC or SDR21 PVC. Concrete Pipe Class III or heavier depending on loading conditions may be used for 12' or larger diameter storm sewers. ADS N-12 smooth bore polyethylene pipe may be used for storm sewers outside of building on private property. No galvanized pipes allowed.
- P-4 Fernco couplings may be used on repair work on existing conditions and only above ground.
- P-5 Fernco couplings with stainless jackets may be used underground.
- P-6 Cleanouts shall be placed as close as possible top the curb box, near the curb line, between the property line and the curb line. Such cleanouts should be recessed below finished grade and have a cast iron cap to allow locating with a magnetic dip needle.
- P-7 Rockford Grease Separators or equal will be accepted for proper installation for grease interception, including restaurants.

- I-1 Drains under dumpsters must be piped in a similar manner but the drainage area must be limited to the immediate dumpster pad. Floor drains to be connected to the sanitary sewer.
- I-2 No part of the work of any plumbing or drainage shall be covered or concealed in any way until it has been inspected by the Plumbing Inspector. All piping used for plumbing and drainage must be water, smoke or peppermint tested prior to being covered or concealed. Final inspection is required when all work is complete and fixtures are set. Notice must be sent to the Plumbing Inspector when the work is sufficiently advanced for inspection and he or she shall inspect the work within twenty-four (24) hours after being notified.
