# Batavia Youth Bureau & Genesee County YMCA "Liberty Center" Rules

#### **Center Rules**

- 1. Appropriate conduct is expected at all times while involved in programs.
- 2. Smoking is not allowed in the building or on the premises.
- 3. Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, and weapons are strictly prohibited. Anyone appearing to be under the influence will be asked to leave.
- 4. "Hanging Out" outside of the building is not allowed.
- 5. Illegal activity in or around the building will result in immediate or permanent expulsion, the Police will be notified.
- 6. Marking, defacing, or misuse of the equipment or the building will not be allowed. Such action will result in suspension until restitution is made.
- 7. Equipment may not be removed or borrowed from the program.
- 8. Fighting, gambling, boisterous conduct and profanity are strictly prohibited.
- 9. The center's phone is for emergency calls only.
- 10. Liberty Center is for 9 16 year olds. You must be enrolled in school.
- 11. Game rules must be followed at all times or you will be asked to sit out.
- 12. Every participant will complete a registration form with a parent/guardian name and home number included for emergency contact.
- 13. Every participant must sign in when they arrive and sign out when they leave.
- 14. Youth are not allowed to wander the building.
- 15. No food or drinks allowed outside of the cafeteria.
- 16. No rollerblades, scooters, skateboards or bikes allowed inside the building. Please remove before entering the building.
- 17. The penalty for violation of any of these rules can result in a temporary or permanent suspension, depending on the situation.
- 18. The Youth Bureau/Genesee County YMCA is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please keep personal items of value at home.
- 19. All participants need to be in attendance at school to participant in Liberty Center activities.

## **Bullying Policy**

Liberty Center strictly prohibits discriminating, harassment and/or bullying against any student, by employees or students, that creates a hostile after school environment by conduct t, or by threats, intimidation or abuse, including cyberbullying, that:

- has or would have the effort of unreasonably and substantially interfering with a student's educational performance, opportunities or benefits, or mental, emotional and/or physical wellbeing; or
- reasonably causes or would reasonably to expected to cause a student to fear for his or her physical safety; or
- reasonably causes or would reasonably be expected to cause physical injury or emotional harm to a student; or
- occurs off center property and creates or would foreseeably create a risk of substantial disruptive within the center environment, where it is foreseeable that the conduct, threats, intimidation or abuse might reach center property.

### **Emergency Policy**
